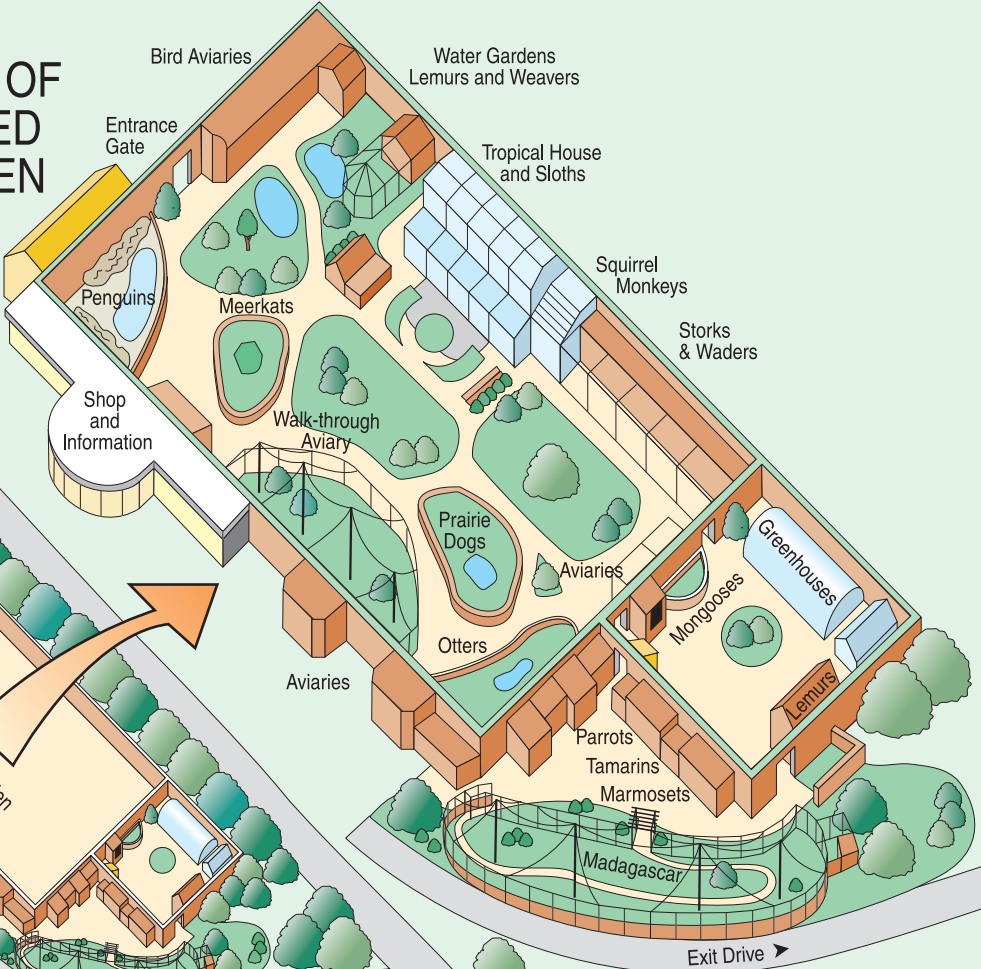







DETAIL OF WALLED GARDEN
